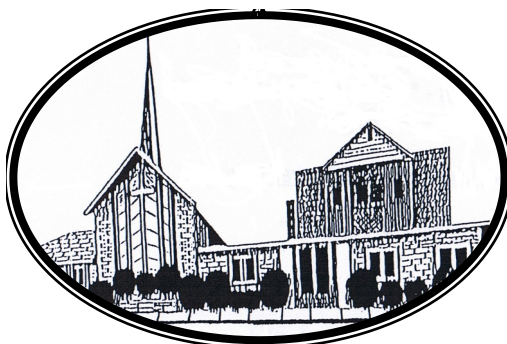

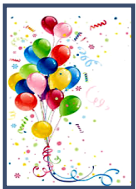

The Richland County Addiction Prevention Coalition invites you to join us from 6:30-8:30pm on May 17 at the OCC auditorium to learn more about the Opioid Epidemic.
