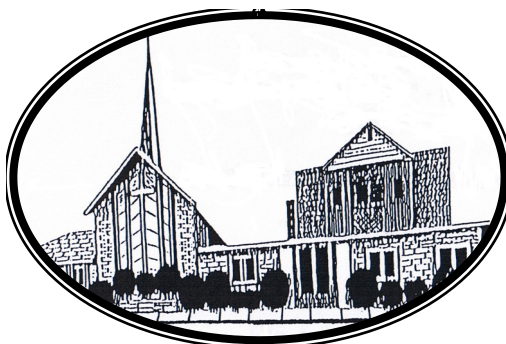

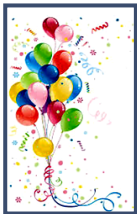

Understanding the Opioid Epidemic

The Richland County Addiction Prevention Coalition invites you to join us from 6:30-8:30pm on May 17 at the OCC auditorium to learn more about the Opioid Epidemic.

Documentary Screening: The Heroin Project—this documentary tells the story of the heroine epidemic around the Madison County area and how it affects the entire community.

Question & Answer with Expert Panel—Attendees will participate in a discussion with community experts including law enforcement, the recovery community, first responders and other community members about opioids.

Hands On Narcan Training—Health instructors from the Egyptian Health Department will educate attendees on recognizing an opioid overdose and how to administer the life saving medication, Narcan. Attendees will receive a Narcan kit.

Admission is free and open to the public.
